The Apostle Paul's Testimony (After 30 years of ministry):

Acts 26:6 (62 AD) And now I stand and am judged for the hope of the made by God to our fathers. ⁷ To this ______ our twelve tribes, earnestly serving God night and day, ______ to attain. For this hope's sake, King Agrippa, I am accused by the Jews.⁸ Why should it be thought incredible by you that God ?⁹ Indeed, I myself thought I must do many things contrary to the name of Jesus of Nazareth.¹⁰ This I also did in Jerusalem, and many of the saints I shut up in prison, having received authority from the chief priests; and when they were put to death, I cast my vote against *them.*¹¹ And I punished them ______ in every synagogue and compelled *them* to blaspheme; and being exceedingly _____ against them, I persecuted *them* even to foreign cities.¹² "While thus occupied, as I journeyed to Damascus with authority and commission from the chief priests, ¹³ at midday, O king, along the road I saw a ______ from heaven, brighter than the sun, shining around me and those who journeyed with me.¹⁴ And when we all had fallen to the ground, I heard a speaking to me and saying in the Hebrew language, 'Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting _? *It is* hard for you to kick against the goads.' ¹⁵ So I said, 'Who are You, Lord?'
