Luke 13:10 Now He was teaching in one of the synagogues on the Sabbath. <sup>11</sup> And behold, there was a woman who had a spirit of \_\_\_\_\_ eighteen years, and was bent over and could in no way raise *herself* up. <sup>12</sup> But when Jesus saw her, He called *her* to *Him* and said to her, "Woman, you are loosed from your infirmity." <sup>13</sup> And \_\_\_\_\_ her, and immediately she was made straight, and glorified God. <sup>14</sup> But the \_\_\_\_\_ of the synagogue answered with \_\_\_\_\_, because Jesus had healed on the Sabbath; and he said to the crowd, "There are six days on which men ought to work; therefore come and be healed on them, and not on the Sabbath day." <sup>15</sup> The Lord then answered him and said, "Hypocrite! ## The Early Church Lays Hands on the Sick

Acts 4:13 Now when they saw the boldness of Peter and John, and perceived that they were \_\_\_\_\_, they marveled. And they realized that they had been with Jesus. <sup>14</sup> And seeing the man who had been \_\_\_\_\_ standing with them, they could say \_\_\_\_\_ against it. <sup>15</sup> But when they had commanded them to go aside out of the council, they conferred among themselves, <sup>16</sup> saying, "What shall we do to these men? For, indeed, that a notable \_\_\_\_\_ has been done through them *is* evident to all who dwell in Jerusalem, and \_\_\_\_\_." <sup>17</sup> But so that it spreads no further among the people, let us \_\_\_\_\_ them, that from now on they speak to no man in this name." <sup>18</sup> And they called them and commanded them not to speak at all nor teach in the name of Jesus. <sup>19</sup> But Peter and John answered and said to them, "Whether it is right in the sight of God to listen to you more than to God, you judge. <sup>20</sup> For we cannot but speak the things which we have seen and heard." <sup>21</sup> So when they had further \_\_\_\_\_ them, they let them go, finding no way of punishing them, because of the people, since they all \_\_\_\_\_ for what had been done. <sup>22</sup> For the man was over forty years old on whom \_\_\_\_\_ had been performed. <sup>23</sup> And being let go, they went to their own *companions* and reported all that the chief priests and elders had said to them. <sup>24</sup> So when they heard that, \_\_\_\_\_ with one accord and said: "\_\_\_\_\_, who made heaven and earth and the sea, and all that is in them, <sup>25</sup> who by the mouth of Your servant David have said: *'Why did the nations rage, And the people plot vain things? <sup>26</sup> The kings of the earth took their stand, And the rulers were gathered together Against the LORD and against His Christ.'* <sup>27</sup> "For truly against Your holy Servant Jesus, whom You anointed, both Herod and Pontius Pilate, with the Gentiles and the people of Israel, were gathered together <sup>28</sup> to do whatever Your \_\_\_\_\_ and Your purpose determined before to be done. <sup>29</sup> Now, Lord, look on their threats, and grant to Your servants that with all \_\_\_\_\_ they may speak Your \_\_\_\_\_, <sup>30</sup> by stretching out Your \_\_\_\_\_, and that signs and wonders may be done through the

\_\_\_\_\_ that he might receive his \_\_\_\_\_." <sup>13</sup> Then Ananias answered, "Lord, I have heard from many about this man, how much harm he has done to Your saints in Jerusalem. <sup>14</sup> And here he has authority from the chief priests to bind all who call on Your name." <sup>15</sup> But the Lord said to him, "Go, for he is a chosen vessel of Mine to bear My name before Gentiles, kings, and the children of Israel. <sup>16</sup> For I will show him how many things he must suffer for My name's sake." <sup>17</sup> And Ananias went his way and entered the house; and \_\_\_\_\_ he said, "Brother Saul, the Lord Jesus, who appeared to you on the road as you came, has sent me that you may receive your sight and be filled with the Holy Spirit." <sup>18</sup> Immediately there fell from his eyes *something* like scales, and he received his sight at once; and he arose and was baptized.
