Making disciples is more than just giving a set of bullet points to believe. Jesus lived out His doctrine in front of His disciples (they eat, slept, and traveled with Him) and He spent over a year teaching them (allowing them to ask questions) before sending them out two by two to preach and minister. Jesus taught and modeled the elementary principles of Christ:

EPOC: Hebrews 6:1 Therefore, leaving the discussion of the elementary *principles* of Christ, let us go on to perfection, not laying again the foundation of **repentance from dead works** and of **faith toward God**,² of the **doctrine of baptisms**, of **laying on of hands**, of **resurrection of the dead**, and of **eternal judgment**.
